

# Take TAVI's New Historic Cemetery Trail

In celebration of our nation's 250<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2026, The Allentown Village Initiative (TAVI) has taken the opportunity to create, along with a number of other projects, the Allentown/Upper Freehold Historic Cemetery Trail. This region is chock




full of history, including that of indigenous peoples (aka Native Americans), who populated this area approximately 12,000 years ago; early European settlers of the 17th and 18th centuries, whose descendants fought for their, and our, freedom during the War for American Independence (we live at the 'Crossroads of the American Revolution': the agrarian/earlyindustrial period of the 19th century, which included the painful period of our own Civil War; and more modern times, which have seen an evolution away from an economy largely focused

on agriculture to one more focused on light industry and the service sector.

The cemeteries included on TAVI's new tour are the resting place of young and old, rich and poor, famous and not so famous — ordinary citizens and extraordinary individuals who served their families, their communities, their state, and their country with love, dignity, dedication, and pride.

you'll learn the stories of Revolutionary War heroes, governors, statesmen, Civil War veterans, farmers and ordinary folk who lived in the towns we now call home.


## LAST CALL FOR FALL DAFFODILS --




## Warehouses, Warehouses Everywhere!

Did you know that there are at least two warehouse development proposals pending in our community? Recent attention has focused on the Stein Property bordering Allentown on North Main Street by the I-195 Interchange. Opposition to another application, however, has been ongoing for three years: The Alliance for Sustainable Communities – TASC continues to litigate before the Appellate Division in order to block the construction of warehouses in Mercer Corporate Park off County Route 526 (pictured below). Residents maintain the warehouses will bring excessive traffic as well as noise and light pollution and destroy important wildlife habitat. The proposals also appear to be at odds with Upper Freehold Township's Country Code, which sets forth the municipality's commitment to "the rural life" philosophy which will continue to provide a "Country Lifestyle" to residents. 
